

To all Chapter members,

Encouraging each of you to complete and submit your 2023-2024 TASO Officiating Record or better known as the TASO Summary Points form. The form is located on the chapter website **RGVBBCHAPTER.COM** under the main menu, "forms."

**GAME POINTS 2023-2024:** Submitting the end-of-season points total each year is important. Your points reflect the number of games and types of games officiated (Varsity, sub Varsity, Middle School) during the season, the participation in the TASO State/Regional educational meetings, Rules/Mechanics test scores, scrimmages completed, Officiating Camps attended which combined determine the total season points.

Over the years the points add up; your ranking – starting with (division) D5 and ultimately up to D1 – documents your educational and game experience as a basketball official. The divisions scale is listed below:

**Division V = 0 to 74 points**

**Division IV = 75 to 299 points**

**Division III = 300 to 749 points**  
**Division II = 750 to 1499 points**

**Division I = 1500 and above points**

**TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR GAMES OFFICIATED BEFORE NEXT SEASON:** Recommend each member submit game the Points form now. When the Arbiter administrator resets the Arbiter accounts, the assignment schedule in your Arbiter account will be cleared and reset to zero games.

**Summary Form / Directions:**

**If you attended the TASO state meeting in Edinburg on September 17, 2023, credit yourself 25 points. If you viewed the TASO online clinic in your member's portal, credit yourself 15 points. (Note: You CANNOT claim both clinic/state meeting credits).** Exam credit is limited to the highest test score according to TASO Past President Calvin Harris. There was NO Regional or District clinic for RGV members. The RGV camp was TASO approved camp. Fill in the remaining boxes; complete the form.

**What to do:**

Complete, print and submit the points form. The TASO Summary Points form is posted on the chapter website **RGVBBCHAPTER.COM**. Use your Arbiter record (in your Arbiter account) as a guide to document the games you have officiated.

**What will happen:** The chapter recording secretary sends an updated roster to TASO which updates your point total and division status in your permanent TASO database record. The points and divisions information will also be posted on the chapter roster and in your Arbiter account.
